

Community Consultation Committee Nominations Port of Broome

The Port of Broome supports Western Australia's North West livestock exports, pearling, fishing and charter boats, cruise liner tourism and government vessel visits. Broome is the main break bulk, and fuel terminal for the Kimberley and is a support base for the offshore Browse Basin oil and gas activities.

In accordance with section 14A of the Port Authorities Act 1999 Kimberley Ports Authority is seeking nominations to fill three positions being: two community and one tourism industry representative on the Community Consultation Committee (**Committee**).
